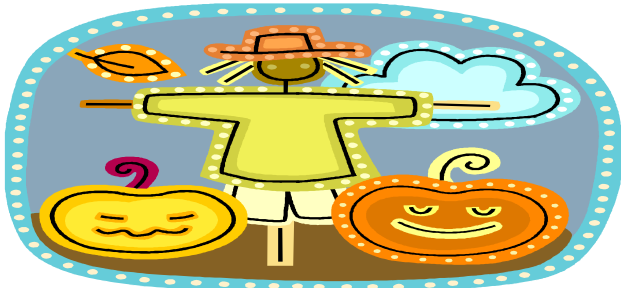

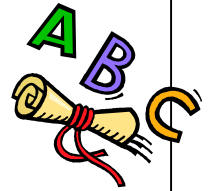


Also, I had a chance to
